

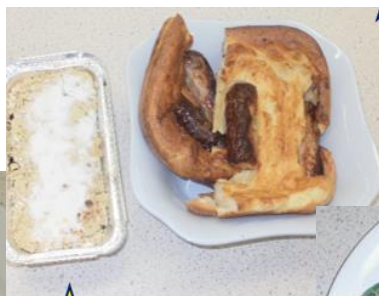
# CEDAR HALL SCHOOL NEWSLETTER

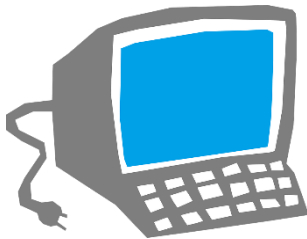
