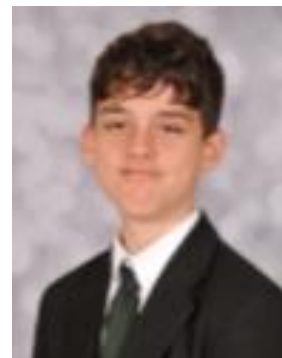


The Gardening Trophy
