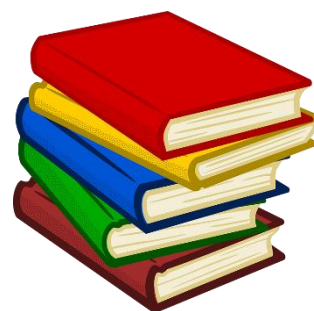

Cedar Hall's Online Payment System

Over two thirds of our parents are now using our on-line payment system which is helping to reduce the amount of cash that comes into school, making paying for school activities safer and more efficient. The system is called *School Gateway*. If you haven't already signed up, this is what you need to do:-

1. Go to www.schoolgateway.com
2. When you visit the *School Gateway* website for the first time, please select 'New User' and enter your email address and mobile telephone number you have registered with the school.
3. The system will send a PIN code to your phone; please enter this PIN code and your account will be activated for you.

As soon as you've got the system set-up, you'll be able to pay money to the school online rather than sending in cash or cheques. There is also an app available to download, making the system even easier.
